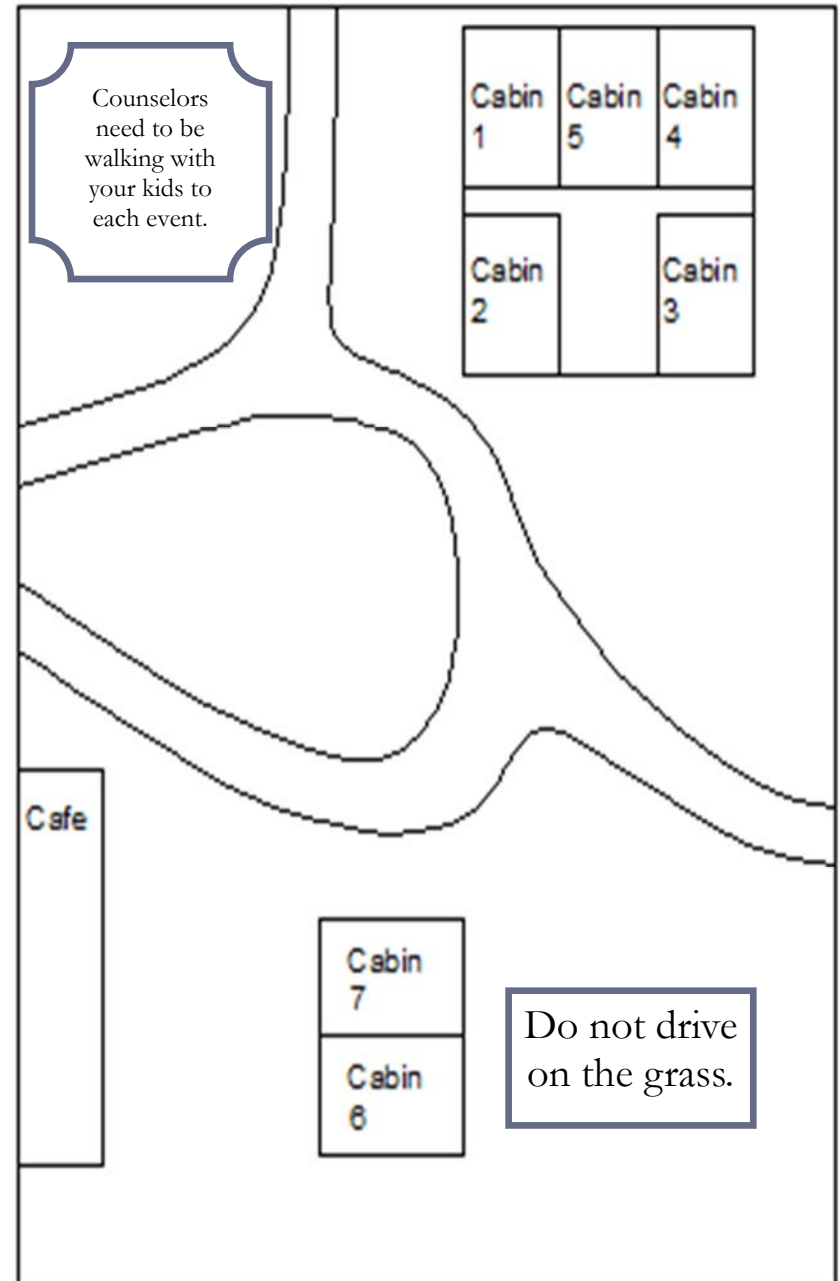

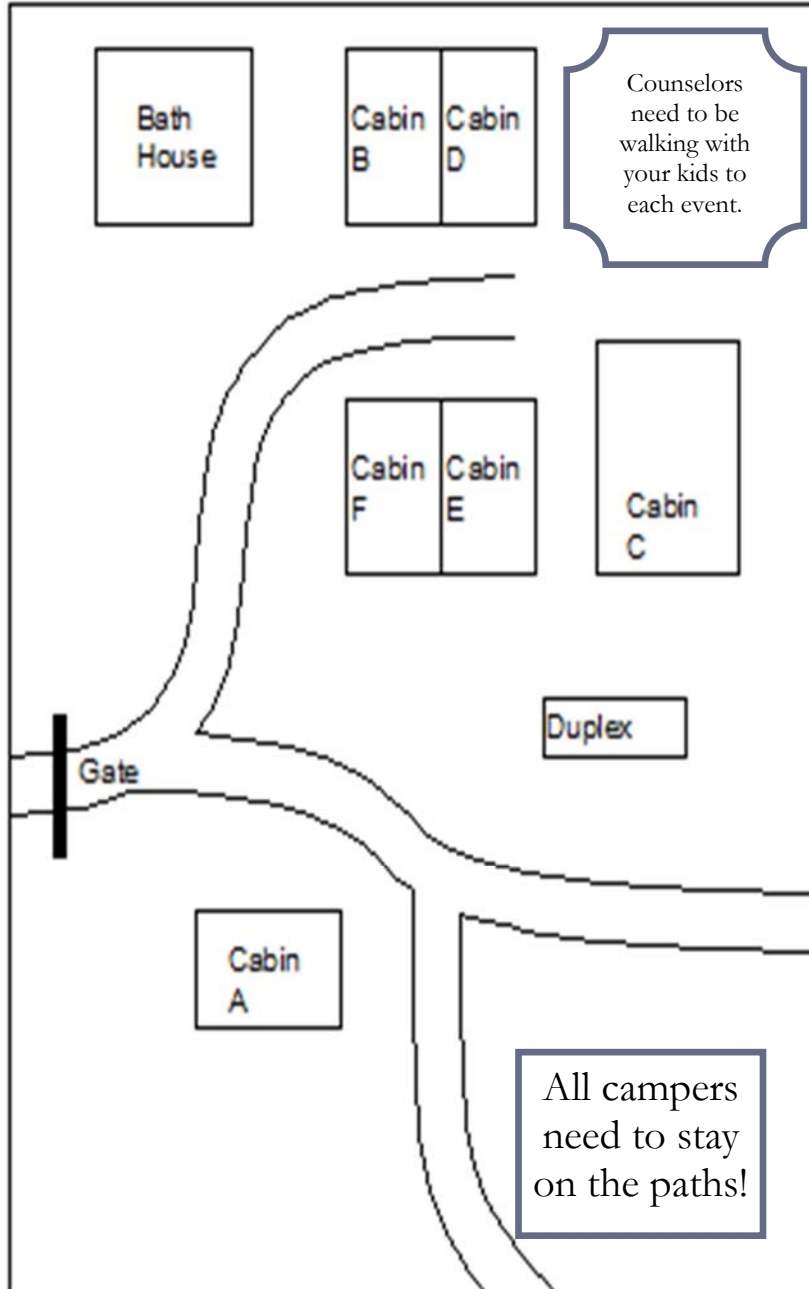

Boys Cabin Layout



1. Our job is to care for our campers. Keep them safe; physically, emotionally, and spiritually.
2. Sunday afternoon prior to the counselor meeting; greet your campers at the cabin and help them get settled. Give them info of the schedule for that day and help with directions.
3. Make all campers feel welcome, especially those who are new.
4. Continually be on the lookout for "loners".
5. Check to make sure your campers have everything they need. Some may have forgotten necessary items and may not ask to get something.
6. Riding in back of vehicles or golf carts is not permitted; please discourage it.
7. Counselor cars may be parked at the cabins.
8. Both counselor from each cabin must be at swim time and both at craft each day.
9. Enforce camp rules.
10. When campers are in the cabin, you must be there too. One counselor must attend trips to cabins.
11. Monitor camper behavior during worship and devotional times. A counselor needs to be with the campers who leave these activities.
12. All talent entries must be screened. Please save everyone from embarrassment.
13. Check to see that campers are covered appropriately when traveling to/from pool.
14. Know when your cabin/team has a job and see that it's done.
15. Encourage team spirit and unity, pray before each sporting activity.
16. Make sure campers are where they are supposed to be continually.
17. During sports, swimming, arts and crafts, campers need to be at the activity, no exceptions.
18. Make sure campers show up on time to help with kitchen duties and no one leaves until dismissed by kitchen director or counselor.
19. Be a role model, follow rules that campers have to follow.
21. Serve people and pitch in where needed.
22. Attend all activities unless there is a need with a camper.
23. Dress Code to be monitored by each cabin's counselor. If you have problem with camper outside your cabin see head boys or girl's counselors.
24. Counselors who aren't teaching camper classes need to be in a bible class.
25. Monitor bathroom supplies and replenish if there's a need.
26. No staff/camper relationships.
27. Have cabin and other duties covered before leaving camp on Saturday...do not leave your work for someone else.

## Camper Rules and Expectations

1. Be where you are supposed to be and be on time.
2. Stay inside your cabin after lights out. Only exception: going to the bathhouse. This Includes FRIDAY NIGHT!
3. Campers must be accompanied by counselors when in cabins.
4. Go to nurse at appropriate times for medications.
5. Stay hydrated. Drink water and/or Gatorade.
6. Keep all drinks and snacks around the Canteen Area.
7. Keep the camp clean by throwing all trash in trash bins.
8. Camper cars are to be parked at the mess hall for entire camp session. Permission to go to cars during camp must be obtained from counselor/director.
9. Sign out in the mess hall if leaving camp. Prior permission/notification must be provided by parent/camper to the director and cabin counselor.

### Respect:

1. You need to be respectful at all times.
2. You need to be quiet when someone is addressing a group.
3. When any adult raises their hand for silence, raise your hand and close your mouth.
4. Use quiet voices at the baptistry area.
5. You need to be respectful of others belongings.

### Clothing: NOTE: STAFF YOU WILL NEED TO FOLLOW THE SAME DRESS CODE AS THE CAMPER TO SET THE EXAMPLE

The directors of Camp Hensel are concerned about the type of clothing worn at camp. They have decided that jeans, modest shorts (**no shorter than 6 inches above the knee**), and modest shirts will be the only acceptable clothing for activities. Shirts must not be see-through, and can be sleeveless as long as all undergarments are properly covered, and they are not tank tops. **NO SOPHIE or RUNNING SHORTS (Running shorts are permitted with spandex underneath), SPAGHETTI STRAPS, TANK TOP, OR CROP-TOP TYPE, AND ALL SHIRTS MUST HANG BELOW THE WAIST LINE.** Campers not abiding by these guidelines will be issued alternative clothing or may be subject to dismissal. **PLEASE, MODEST SWIM SUITS.**

## General Rules

1. Writing on buildings or structures is not allowed.
2. Pick up trash when you see it and put it in the trash bins.
3. When a meal is served; ask for only what you will eat.
4. **Hand holding is the only acceptable form of PDA.**
5. Participate actively during Reflection Time.
6. Everything at camp is for the purpose of glorifying God and to strengthen our relationships with Him, His Son, and each other.

### Electronic Policy Including Phones:

1. Campers will be allowed to have their cell phones to use during the day but must be respectful with them at all times.
2. They may be used for alarms, electronic bibles, to take appropriate pictures, and to communicate with parents.
3. They may NOT be used in any bathroom or shower facility, as a distraction during any activity including bible classes and worship times. Inappropriate audio/video will not be played from them as well. Make sure no one is changing or not dressed appropriately while taking pictures or videos in the cabins
4. Abuse of this policy will be cause for confiscation of cell phones/MP3 players. They will be given to the director/his designee and may be asked for no later than Saturday morning.

### Cabin Inspections

This will be performed daily during sports. Prior to that cabin counselors should supervise clean up.

Tasks to accomplish:

1. Beds made
2. Trash picked up/cans emptied
3. Pick up any trash outside
4. Floor swept
5. If it's your cabins assigned day for bathhouse duty, sweep and clean it out.
6. Bag all trash and set out for pickup near the road every morning.

Cabin reports will be announced before lunch.

*If a cabin receives 'Black Cabin', that cabin will sweep out the amphitheater during free time and pick up trash around camp. Two days in a row with Black Cabin will result in cleaning the bath house before bed that night. 'Gold Cabin' will be first in line from lunch to breakfast on the next day.*

## Meal Duty and Kitchen Help

NOTE: COUNSELING STAFF MAKE A NOTE OF WHEN YOU ARE SUPPOSE TO BE ON MEAL AND KITCHEN DUTY.

IF YOU HAVE THE MORNING DEVO BE AT THE BACK PORCH A LITTLE EARLY AND TRY AND GET EVERYONE TO PARTICIPATE.

### Meal Duty Task

**\*\*\*\*Get this done quickly. Don't allow this group to hold up the schedule. \*\*\*\***

**Make sure you are not late to an event. If you cannot complete the task the staff will take care of it.**

#### Before Meal

1. Take down chairs
2. Wipe tables with disinfectant spray
3. Put out salt & pepper shakers

#### After Meal

1. Pick up salt & pepper shakers
2. Wipe tables with disinfectant spray
3. Take out trash including the restrooms
4. Sweep & Mop floors
5. Put chairs back on tables

#### Kitchen Help

1. Wash, dry, and put up trays and dishes
2. Return towels/supplies to kitchen
3. Wipe down area with disinfectant
4. **Bathrooms – sweep and mop floors, wipe down, re-supply soap/paper towels/toilet paper/ and take out trash.**
5. **Sweep and Mop the Floors One time a day (Non-Counseling Staff) . This will be done after lunch each day.**

## Swimming Policy

NOTE: ALL STAFF MUST SIGN THE SWIMMING POLICY AGREEMENT.

There will be adequate lifesaving personnel available per the state recommendation of the following.

*“For every 35 campers, or fraction thereof, engaged in waterfront activities, there shall be one certified lifeguard and one additional person (either a certified lifeguard or trained adult lookout) on duty. Camps utilizing natural bodies of water such as rivers, lakes, or creeks may need to increase this ratio.”*

CTCC Inc. requires all swimmers to pass the swim test. The swim test is as follows:

All swimmers will show that they can swim without assistance in order to use the rope swing, diving platform, and swim in the deeper side of the creek. To pass the swim test you must swim from the shallow side of the creek to the deep side. All lifesaving personnel and assistant staff will form a line across the path to help the swimmer if it's needed.

All swimmers that do not pass the test will be allowed to swim on the shallow side only.

All swimmers will be placed on a “buddy system”. The buddy system is where each swimmer has a partner. Every 20 minutes the lifesaving personnel will call for a buddy check prompting all swimmer to get out of the water and to join with their buddy. Once all the swimmers are accounted for then the swimming ensue.

## Bad Weather Policy

NOTE: ALL STAFF MUST SIGN THE BAD WEATHER POLICY AGREEMENT.

In the event of bad weather, all CTCC campers and guests are moved to safe areas as quickly as possible. All campers are assembled in the safest of structures at the Camp Hensel facility.

The bad weather policy will be read to all staff and campers the first night of camp. This policy covers any and all types of bad weather that may happen during the camp session.

To all campers and staff if bad weather presents itself you are to do the following:

Be aware to the bad weather announcement made by the director. The announcement will be made in a text form, phone call, and/or visit to your location.

Staff gather your campers

Campers include those in your cabin, classes, and/or activities

Proceed to the closest of the buildings listed as a safe zone shelter

Once you are there send a completed list of kids via text to 817.773.2775. If you feel someone is missing please make us aware of that as well.

In the safe zone shelters take the appropriate measures to keep all campers and staff as safe as possible.

**How to teach someone about becoming a Christian**

The decision to become a new testament Christian is the most important decision a person can ever make. It’s worth taking time to pray, study, and think carefully about before making the commitment.

*Through out the new testament we see patterns in the behavior of the early Christians. For Example:*

- Revelation 1:10—they started calling Sunday “the Lord’s Day”
- Acts 2:42/1 Cor. 11:23-26—They got together regularly to take communion “break bread” and remember the Lord.

We follow their example and gather weekly on Sundays and remember Jesus by taking communion together.

*Lets look at some examples in scripture how people became Christians.*

Acts 2:36-41, Acts 4:1-4, Acts 8:9-13, Acts 9:11-19

What patterns do you see in the ways people became Christians in the New Testament?

- They heard someone teaching about Jesus
- They showed evidence of repenting and wanting to change their life
- They prayed a prayer to God asking for salvation
- They confessed openly that they believed in Jesus
- They were baptized into Christ

Paul writes many letters in the New Testament about living as a Christian.

Romans 6:1-14—Here Paul talks about how to become a Christian and when a person becomes a Christian. He also talks about how a person behavior should be different after they becoming a Christian.
